Step	Description
Hearings 1 & 2 August 21 & 28	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Held prior to release of draft maps• Education and to solicit input on the composition of Trustee Areas
<i>Draft Maps Posted</i> <i>September 4</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be posted on the project website seven (7) days in advance of Hearing 3
Hearing 3 September 11	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• First Board consideration of draft maps
Hearing 4 October 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Board consideration of draft maps
Hearing 5/Map Adoption October 16	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Public hearing followed by map adoption

- Planned future growth

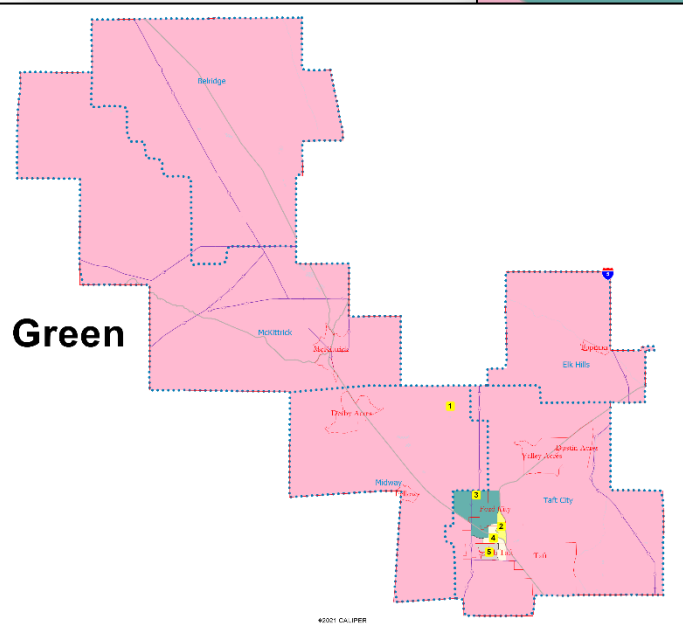
